I. Call to order

Mike Woodring called to order the regular meeting of the Magic City Soccer Board at 7:00 pm on November 8, 2010 at the Magic City Soccer Office. II. Approval of minutes from last meeting

The minutes from the last meeting were approved as written. Mike Mayott made the motion and Todd Preston seconded the motion.

III. Gabriel Rood, U.S. Club Soccer western region representative, participated via teleconference to present an overview of U.S. Club Soccer and take questions.

Discussion revolved around how dual registration with U.S. Club Soccer and MYSA might offer better opportunities for upper age group teams interested in seeking regional competition that is more closely aligned with our teams' abilities. A working group was tasked with drawing up an information sheet team coaches and parents can use on a team-by-team basis to decide whether or how to take advantage of those opportunities. At the conclusion of Mr. Rood's presentation and our questions, Mike Mayott put forth the following motion, the Magic City Soccer Club dual register the U15-U18 boys and girls teams for the 2011 season. Each team is to decide whether to register select or premier with MYSA. The MCSC office is to be notified by the team of their decision by Monday November 29th. Any team which chooses premier will be assessed a \$16 per player fee. The motion was seconded by Todd Preston. It was voted on by the board and passed.

- IV. Larry Van Atta- Past President
Larry applied for and received on behalf of the Magic City Soccer Club a \$500 equipment grant from RBC.
- V. Shelley Prosinski-
Shelley has been working with Creative Monograms to develop a Magic Wear line. There are now 24 items available with Magic licensed logo. Dennis and Shelley met with a representative from Creative Monograms to discuss some website issues. The club will receive \$2 per item ordered. Pictures to update the website will need to be supplied by the club.
- VI. Shelly Cornell- Registrar
1. We received 32 MICRO registrations. We have a total of 83 MICRO registrations as of 10/30/2010
 2. We received 46 U15+ registrations for Spring 2011. **As of this morning, we have a total of 86 that are registered to tryout Sunday.** We have a total of 267 for all competitive age groups as of 10/31/2010.
 3. We posted rosters for our U11 and U12 boys and girls teams.
 4. We picked up 2 players for our U11 Girls White team. These girls were already registered for MICRO and we moved their registrations from MICRO to competitive.
 5. I have contacted all the players currently rostered to our U13 and U14 teams who have not made their final payments (due 10/10) to see if any players intend to drop. Most of them have contacted me with their intentions, but still waiting on a few.

6. We had one official drop from our U13 Girls Red team. We have pulled a girl from our waiting list and I am waiting for her registration paperwork to be turned in and processed.
7. We currently have one more U13 girl on our waiting list.

Mike Woodring adjourned the meeting at approximately 9:10 pm.
